

## Sanitary and phytosanitary (SPS) training

If you are involved in Food and Agri business, and you import/export or distribute food products to or from outside of the EU, including Great Britain (GB), it is imperative that you understand the requirements for importing/exporting food, including SPS requirements, in order to avoid delays at the Port. Sanitary and Phytosanitary (SPS) measures are designed to protect human, animal and plant health from diseases, pests or contaminants.

**These SPS controls are prescribed in EU law and are mandatory.**

Sanitary refers to live animals, food of animal origin, germinal products and animal by products.

Phytosanitary refers to plants, plant products, fruit, veg and horticulture products.

**What businesses need to know about food import/export requirements?**

The EU has very strict controls on the imports of animals and animal related products. The controls can consist of a documentary check, an identity or a physical check or any combination of these checks. The nature of what is required will depend on the type of food, with some exports also requiring an export health certificate or a phytosanitary certificate. **What are the risks?**

If you do not complete the SPS import/export formalities your goods are at a risk of:



Lengthy delays



Refused entry to EU/GB



Destruction costs/return of the goods to the exporter

This could result in your being unable to serve your final customer in sufficient time or a complete write-off if they are perishable.
