

Customs Clearance Training



The Brexit Transition Period ended on 31st of December 2020. As of 1st of January 2021, all Irish importers and exporters trading with the UK are required to lodge customs declarations with Revenue to account for their imports and exports.

What businesses need to know about customs declarations?

Completing customs declarations is not straightforward and usually businesses who trade internationally engage a specialist to perform this task.

An inability to make customs declarations will now directly affect the ability of traders to move goods and may threaten the viability of many businesses.

It is also widely accepted that there is a critical shortage of customs clearance agents to make declarations on behalf of traders and, therefore, many businesses are being forced to bring this function in-house in order to trade with partners in the UK.

What are the risks?

If you are unable to complete a customs declaration or you complete a declaration incorrectly, your goods are at an extreme risk of lengthy delays at the border. This could result in you being unable to serve your final customer in sufficient time or a complete write off of your goods if they are perishable.

As well as this, you are now completing customs declarations and, as such, you are also liable to a customs audit. If Revenue find that you have completed incorrect customs declarations, you may be liable to fines or additional customs charges.

How can we help?
