

# **Customs import declaration training**

# Did you know, the most common reason for non-compliance is in relation to the content and quality of the customs declaration?

In this course, you'll discover how to correctly complete customs declarations and ensure that your business stays on the right side of the law.

## Why should I learn?

A customs declaration is always required when moving goods across the border.

Completing customs declarations is not straightforward and businesses may wish to engage a specialist to perform this task on their behalf, usually a customs agent.

However, it is important to note that the full responsibility lies with the trader (importer/exporter) not the customs representative.

# What risks could your business face if you are noncompliant?

If you are stated as the importer or the exporter on the customs declaration, you may be selected for a customs audit.

Even though your goods have been cleared by customs, noncompliance with customs legislation may not be spotted until a customs audit is completed by Revenue.

If Revenue find that you/or your agent have completed incorrect customs declarations, you may be liable to fines or additional customs charges.
